

Entering Into Worship Confessions

1st Chronicles 16:25, 28-29

²⁵For great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised: he also is to be feared above all gods.

²⁸Give unto the LORD, ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

²⁹Give unto the LORD the glory *due* unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

I want to thank You, and praise You, and worship You, just because of who You are. You are, Jehovah, the mighty One, my God in whom I trust.

I respect You, Lord. I praise You, Lord, and I magnify You, Lord. You alone are worthy to be adored. You alone are worthy to be worshipped and adored.

Jesus, I call you my Savior, my healer, my business partner, my King! Jesus You are my great physician, my healer, the strength of my heart and my portion forever! Thank You, Jesus. I praise You, Jesus.

I thank You Lord Jesus for bringing me into the presence of the Father. You said the Father loves me and I believe You. The Father does love me.

I praise You and thank You for Your Word. Your Word is true *and I believe it. . . .*

Lord, I just want to tell You how much I love You, and praise You and thank You, and worship You. You are great and glorious. You are the God of Heaven, and the only true God. I am Your child and I'm in Your family.

Heavenly Father, You said to draw near to You and You would draw near to me.

I draw near to You and believe You are everything Your Word says You are to me.

Heavenly Father, Jesus said You are the giver of all good gifts. I believe that! You are *my Father*. You are *my provider*. You are *my healer*. You are my prosperity.

Father, I take You at Your Word, I believe Your Word; and because I believe Your Word, I confess it! I take sides with You and Your Word. What You said about me is true.

Father, You said in Your Word that Jesus is my right-standing with You, my wisdom, my sanctification, and my redemption.

Entering Into Worship Confessions

Deuteronomy 28:1-13

¹And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe *and* to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:

²And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.

³Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field.

⁴Blessed shall be the fruit of thy body, and the fruit of thy ground, and the fruit of thy cattle, the increase of thy kine, and the flocks of thy sheep.

⁵Blessed shall be thy basket and thy store.

⁶Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.

⁷The LORD shall cause thine enemies that rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face: they shall come out against thee one way, and flee before thee seven ways.

⁸The LORD shall command the blessing upon thee in thy storehouses, and in all that thou settest thine hand unto; and he shall bless thee in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.

⁹The LORD shall establish thee an holy people unto himself, as he hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the LORD thy God, and walk in his ways.

¹⁰And all people of the earth shall see that thou art called by the name of the LORD; and they shall be afraid of thee.

¹¹And the LORD shall make thee plenteous in goods, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy ground, in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers to give thee.

¹²The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

¹³And the LORD shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath;

I magnify You and praise You. I worship You! You are everything that the Word says You are to me. You are in Covenant with me.

You made the Covenant and I agree with it. *I believe it.* I speak what You said about me and You said that everything I'll ever need is legally mine through Christ Jesus.

Father, You said I am already full and I am already rich. All things are mine through Christ Jesus my Lord. *It is impossible for You to lie!*

Father, You said in Your Word that I have been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus. *I believe that!*

Father, You said that through Christ Jesus I have been made to reign as a King and Priest. *I believe that!* You said that I am an heir of God and joint-heir through my Lord Jesus Christ.

I call myself everything You called me in Your Word.

FATHER, In Jesus' Name I thank You for giving me the power of the tongue; it releases Your authority in my life. My world is made by what I say. I will only speak what You said about me and who I am through Christ Jesus. I will only say what You said about me, my family, and what You have in store for my life!

I call myself everything God calls me

I say what God says . . . I am . . .

I believe what God said about Me!

Romans 4:16-21 - Continued

²⁰ He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

²¹ And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

Isaiah 26:3-4

³ Thou wilt keep *him* in perfect peace, *whose mind is stayed on thee*: because he trusteth in thee.

Father, I thank You and praise You for Wisdom; I have wisdom, and I know what to do all the time. Wisdom is to confess what You said about me. I confess it and believe it!

Father, I worship You and thank You that I can come boldly to Your throne room! I love you! I adore You! I praise You!

Your Word is working in my life! Your Word is working in my body! Your Word is working in my family! Your Word is working on my job! The promotion of God is mine! I will praise You forever!

(Worship is to flow from your heart and this is only a sample way of entering into worship. Now go back to page one and repeat again putting all of your heart into your praise, worship and confessions.)

Mark 11:22-24
